Release Notes

The product release notes in this document are for EDMA3 Resource Manager, which is a part of the EDMA3 Low Level Driver package. The Resource Manager is a TI mandated library for all EDMA3 peripheral users to acquire and configure EDMA3 hardware resources (DMA/QDMA channels, PaRAM Sets, TCCs etc.) and DMA Interrupt Service Routines. The Resource Manager is made generic across SoCs and across Operating Systems.

1 In This Release

This is the 01.11.01.XX release of EDMA3 Resource Manager and contains libraries, sample initilization libraries (excluding DRx4yy and DM360 platforms) and support documents.

This release contains sample OS adaptation layer for BIOS 5, which could be used by BIOS 5 based applications

New features in the components of release

1) TIDSP00012376 - Support for the C6472 and TCI6486 platforms has been implemented.



2 System Requirements

This release requires the following products (apart from the EDMA3 LLD package):

- ❖ DSP-BIOS 5.41.03.17 or higher
- CCS 3.3.80.11 (service release 10)
- CCS 4.0.0.16 or higher (optional)
- Code Generation Tools 6.1.12
- ❖ XDC tool 3.16.03.36 or higher (optional)
- ❖ XDS 510 USB Emulator (Optional) EVM has on board emulator
- Any of the supported platforms: DM644x, DM646x, DM643x, DM648, C6424, C6452, C6455, OMAP2430, OMAP25xx, OMAP3430, OMAP35xx, DRx40x, DM360, C6474, TCI6488, DA830, C6747, OMAPL137, DRA44x, DRx45x, C6748, OMAPL138, C6472 and TCI6486 EVMs.
- eBinder IDE 1.7 (optional)
- PrKernel version 4 (optional)
- ❖ BSPs (optional)



3 Installation and Usage

- 1) Install the products mentioned in system requirements sections, as per instructions provided along with the products. Please note that sometimes the Code Composer Studio installation contains other components (DSP/BIOS, XDC and Code gen tools etc) and hence it is not required to install them separately.
- 2) Ensure that the BIOS_INSTALL_DIR in the environment variable is set to appropriate DSP/BIOS version. Check the environment variables XDCPATH and XDCROOT, in case EDMA3 LLD is being used in RTSC environment; they should also point to the desired tool chain versions.
- 3) Install the EDMA3 LLD package (EDMA3_LLD_setupwin32_01_11_01_XX.exe (for Windows) / EDMA3_LLD_setuplinux_01_11_01_XX.bin (for Linux)) using the self-extracting installer.
- 4) EDMA3 Resource Manager Source files are available in "edma3_lld_<CURRENT_VERSION>\packages\ti\sdo\edma3\rm\" folder.
- 5) Build the EDMA3 Resource Manager Project files in the build directory (edma3_lld_<CURRENT_VERSION>\packages\ti\sdo\edma3\rm\build\) to build the debug/release library, for the required platform.
- 6) Sample libraries and sample project files are provided with the EDMA3 Resource Manager and are in "edma3_lld_<CURRENT_VERSION>\packages\ti\sdo\edma3\rm\sample\build" folder, in the platform specific folders.



4 Un-installation

- 1) Uninstall the EDMA3 LLD package by using the file uninstall.exe (for windows; for linux, uninstall) in the package directory.
- 2) Un-install the products listed in system requirements as per instructions provided with the product (**optional and at user's discretion**).



5 Fixed In This Release

6 Known Issues

1. EDMA3 hardware doesn't works properly in FIFO mode with all the controllers.

Release Note

Very few peripherals support EDMA3 FIFO mode. EMIF controller doesn't support the same. So EDMA3 CANNOT be used in FIFO mode for doing a mem-2-mem data transfers, EDMA3 being configured in the FIFO mode.

Applications trying to use EDMA3 in FIFO mode should first check their respective peripheral-controller document for this mode support.

- Poll mode support provided for the users who don't want to use the interrupt mechanism to receive the callback. New APIs are provided to check the transfer status, while working in Poll mode.
- ii. New APIs to read/modify the Channel Controller registers are provided.

Changes from 3.0 Release to 3.1 Release:

 Event miss could occur on the DMA/QDMA Channel because of lack of mapping between the channel and TCC code. It is fixed after modifying the Resource Manager interface.

Changes from 2.2 Release to 3.0 Release:

- Renamed EDMA3_DVR to EDMA3_DRV in all locations (header files, source files, project files etc). Also, renamed the directory edma3\src\edma3_dvr to edma3\src\edma3_drv.
- ii. IPR bit clearing in the EDMA3 resource manager ISR issue fixed. Now the IPR bit related to other resources NOT allocated by the resource manager would not be cleared.
- iii. EDMA3 resource manager sample application is broken into multiple files for better understanding and easy porting across different SoCs and OSes.
- iv. Common exhaustive Register Layer is now used for EDMA3 Channel and Transfer Controller, to make porting easier.
